Admission procedures for foreign students coming to the ENSA-PB

Conditions of admission	<p>We recommend that students integrate the ENSA-PB at the beginning of the first semester in September.</p> <p>Students generally come for the second or third year of study (Bachelor's Degree) or for the first year of the Master's degree.</p> <p>Though it is also possible to come for the fifth year of study (second year of the Master's degree). <i>(Students may come for the fifth year of study, in this case they are required to take courses in the Master 1 program).</i></p> <p>In all cases, students are required to enroll in the courses offered in the year for which they are registered. Their course of study should be compatible with the structure of the ENSA-PB program in which they are enrolled.</p> <p>ENSA-PB will only accept students with at least an intermediate level in French (B1).</p>
Application deadline	The application deadline is April, 19th 2019 for the first semester and November, 8th 2019 for the second semester.
Application procedure	The ENSA-PB only accepts applications sent over e-mail by the International Office of the student's home university. Portfolios are not

	<p>necessary.</p> <p>The registrations are made online</p> <p>A certificate of admission, a welcome guide and an academic calendar will be sent to the student.</p>
Language and language courses	<p>All classes are taught in French. Intensive French courses take place in September. French courses are proposed all year round. They are free and organized by the school.</p>
Academic calendar	<p>The academic year, divided in two semesters, lasts 10 months. It runs from late September to mid-July, with a two-week break in December, a one-week break in February, and another two-week break in April.</p>
Pédagogical registration	<p>On the educational registration form, it will be asked to the students to classify studios and courses in order of preference. The school cannot necessarily honor the 1st or second choice.</p> <p>Students are required to enroll in the courses offered in the year for which they are registered. Their course of study should be compatible with the structure of the ENSA-PB program in which they are enrolled.</p>
Learning agreement (for Erasmus+ students only)	<p>A draft version of the learning agreement for 2019-2020 will be established before the student arrives. For more information, we refer you to the guides for the Bachelor's (Licence) and the Master's degrees for 2018-2019. The guides for 2019-2020 will be available as courses are presented. The course of study plan will be finalized after the period of registration for courses.</p>

Health insurance and civil liability Insurance	<p>Health insurance</p> <p>Ø Students who are European Union citizens should send a copy of their valid, up-to-date European social security card.</p> <p>Ø Students who are NOT European Union citizens will have to register on the web site https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/</p> <p>Civil liability Insurance</p> <p>Each student <u>is required</u> to have a civil liability insurance, which covers the damage s/he might cause to others.</p> <p>This insurance can be purchased in France at a cost of about 15 euros.</p>
